

## **The Future of Philosophy**

Philosophy is an ever-evolving discipline influenced by developments in both its content and methods. The latest influence is the explosive and continuing AI revolution. In this talk, I take a look at the (non-existential) threats and opportunities afforded to Philosophy by AI. Perhaps overly optimistically, I claim that there are more opportunities than threats. I then proceed to identify numerous Philosophical functions and methods that would benefit from an AI makeover. This is followed by a discussion of the limitations currently facing AI models as well as corresponding desiderata for models specialised to carry out philosophically-relevant tasks. I conclude with some projections about the future of Philosophy but also some recommendations about what we might do to prepare our students for it.
